It defines three levels of conformance: Level A, Level AA, and Level AAA. At Bang & Olufsen we are currently updating our site for WCAG 2.1 - Level AA conformance. We expect and update in the Summer of 2021.

Assessment approach

Bang & Olufsen A/S works together with experienced accessibility consultants to take the steps necessary to achieve substantial conformance with WCAG. Bang & Olufsen uses the world's leading website governance software company, <u>Siteimprove</u>, to provide various accessibility assessment services that Bang & Olufsen A/S uses to perform continuous self-evaluation of the Bang & Olufsen webshop.

Beside continuous self-evaluation, Bang & Olufsen A/S has assigned an American accessibility company to conduct external assessments documented in a <u>Voluntary Product Accessibility</u> <u>Template® (VPAT®)</u> which evaluates the accessibility of a website according to the <u>Web</u> <u>Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0</u> conformance level A/AA.
